### Harbor Scarf

**SKILL LEVEL:** Intermediate

**SIZE:** One Size

#### MATERIALS

- 150-098 Lion Brand Fishermen's Wool Yarn:  
Natural  
1 Ball

*\*Fishermen's Wool® (Article #150). 100% Pure Virgin Wool*

- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 9 [5.5 mm]

**202:** 78% Pure Virgin Wool, 13% Acrylic, 9% Rayon; package size: 8 oz (227 g), 465 yards (425 m)

**202:** 6 oz (170 g), 348 yards (318 m)

- Lion Brand Cable Needles (Set of 2)
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



#### GAUGE:

30 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) over Cable Pattern.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**2/2 LC (2 over 2 left cross)** Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front, k2, then k2 from cable needle.

**2/2 RC (2 over 2 right cross)** Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in back, k2, then k2 from cable needle.

#### PATTERN STITCH

**Seed Stitch (over an even number of sts)**


**Row 1 (RS):** \*K1, p1; rep from \* across.

**Row 2:** P the knit sts, and k the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for Seed st.

#### NOTES:

1. Scarf is worked in one piece. Center 40 sts are worked in Cable Pattern, remaining sts in Seed st for borders. Stitch markers are used to separate the Seed st sections from the Cable Pattern.
2. Cable Pattern can be worked by following the written instructions or by following the chart.
3. The first and last 3 sts of each row are worked in Seed st for borders and are NOT shown on chart.
4. When working from chart, read RS rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right.



- kon RS, p on WS
- p on RS, kon WS
- 2/2 LC: Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front, k2, then k2 from cable needle
- 2/2 RC: Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in back, k2, then k2 from cable needle

### SCARF

Cast on 46 sts. Work 3 rows in Seed st.

#### Begin Cable Pattern

**Row 1 (RS):** Work 3 sts in Seed st, place marker (pm), p1, k4, p1, k1, p1, k24, p1, k1, p1, k4, p1, pm, work 3 sts in Seed st.

**Rows 2, 4, and 6:** Work 3 sts in Seed st, slip marker (sm), k1, p4, k1, p1, k1, p24, k1, p1, k1, p4, k1, sm, work 3 sts in Seed st.

**Row 3:** Work 3 sts in Seed st, sm, p1, 2/2 LC, p1, k1, p1, (2/2 RC, 2/2 LC) 3 times, p1, k1, p1, 2/2 LC, p1, sm, work 3 sts in Seed st.

**Row 5:** Rep Row 1.

**Row 7:** Work 3 sts in Seed st, sm, p1, 2/2 LC, p1, k1, p1, (2/2 LC, 2/2 RC) 3 times, p1, k1, p1, 2/2 LC, p1, sm, work 3 sts in Seed st.

**Row 8:** Rep Row 2.

Rep Rows 1-8 until Scarf measures about 71 in. (180.5 cm) from beginning.

**Last 3 Rows:** Work in Seed st for ending border.

Bind off.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends.
